

## Aquila reviewing ACT decision

MELBOURNE, July 2 AAP - **Aquila Resources Ltd** says it's reviewing a decision to allow third party access to rail lines owned by BHP Billiton Ltd and Rio Tinto Ltd.

The Australian Competition Tribunal on June 30 declared two rail lines, the Goldsworthy and Robe River rail lines in Western Australia's Pilbara region, open to other users.

Smaller iron ore producers have been pushing to be able to use the railway lines so they can ship ore to ports to sell overseas.

Aquila said the tribunal's decision may give it an opportunity to defer spending on its West Pilbara iron ore project.

"The company notes that the decision of the tribunal may be the subject of an appeal," it said.

"The company will monitor the situation."
