A feasibility study into a proposed mine in Central Qld has found the mine could be operational within three years. Aquila Resources wants to build an open cut mine 24kms north west of Blackwater, producing 400 million tonnes of coal a year of which 1.6 million tonnes is considered high rank coking coal. The Washpool Hard Coking Coal Project would then export through the proposed Wiggins Island coal terminal at Gladstone. Aquila Resources say they are moving forward with the project, finalising the terms of reference for an environmental impact statement.
